## KPC honorees for NFPW milestones

Two women with ties to Kansas Professional Communicators — including a former longtime member of Wichita Professional Communicators — were among the more than 30 NFPW members who were recognized for reaching milestone years of membership at the June NFPW conference.

Jane Lee of Kansas City, Missouri, was honored for reaching 55 years, while Elizabeth “Liz” Kennedy, now a member of the Oregon Press Women, was recognized for her 35-year membership.

Lee began her career as a reporter in the mid-1960s in Lawrence, Kansas. When she started her family, she began working part time in public relations, and in 1984 opened Jane Lee Communications. She won numerous awards, including the NFPW sweepstakes award

in 1998. Lee has served as her affiliate president and on the NFPW board. She retired in 2016.

A lifelong learner, Kennedy earned a Bachelor of Arts in English literature from Brown University and 40 years later, a Master of Science in instructional design and technology from Emporia State University. A freelance writer who now writes an eight-page weekly update on her senior community, she spent 16 years as the About.com children's books expert. A past president and longtime board member of WPC, she also served on the KPC board. A winner of several communications awards, Kennedy was the 2008 Kansas Communicator of Achievement. When she and her husband retired to Portland, Oregon, she continued her NFPW membership with that state's affiliate.

## NFPW 2022 Communications Contest

Earn recognition for the great work you do! The [National Federation of Press Women's 2022 Communications Contest](#) is accepting entries online, and the early bird deadline is Jan. 19. This two-tiered professional contest is open to both members and non-members, with entry fees discounted for members. The first tier of the contest is run at the state level. First-place winners from the state-level contest advance to the national level of judging. To be eligible to compete at the national level, the entrant must be an NFPW member in good standing. Entrants can join NFPW (professional level membership) once they learn of their winning status. NFPW offers numerous contest categories, including writing, editing, photography, graphics and design, radio and television, web and social media, advertising, public relations, speeches and more.
